CCA Plaque Information

The Chihuahua Club of America offers the following plaques to member local Chihuahua Clubs for their specialties:

1. **Best of Breed** - for clubs holding independent specialties.
2. **Best of Variety** - for clubs holding specialties in conjunction with an all-breed show when Best of Breed cannot be offered, and
3. **High in Trial** - for clubs offering obedience at their independent specialties.

The local club's Secretary, Show Chair, and/or Trophy Chair may not be members of the CCA and may be unaware of CCA's requirements for obtaining the plaque. CCA MEMBERS, please make sure that they ALL KNOW the following information:

To receive CCA plaque:

1. Your club's request (Letter/e-mail and Premium List) for a plaque(s) MUST reach CCA's Awards Committee contact At least four (4) weeks prior to your event. (Some clubs include the contact person on their mailing lists to insure that the Premium List is received by CCA's deadline.)

2. Each CCA trophy MUST be published in the actual Premium List, even though a club may use a Condensed premium list for other trophies. The premium list MUST state "Best of Breed" or "Best of Variety" ("Long Coat" and "Smooth Coat") and "High in Trial" - plaque offered by the Chihuahua Club of America, Inc.

3. Deadline: At Least 4 Weeks Prior to your event, mail, e-mail or fax the Awards Committee contact the request for the plaque(s) for your specialty.

Include the DATE of the event and the Name & Address of the person to whom the plaque(s) should be mailed. Your letter may be sent early, however, until the Awards contact receives the premium list, no plaques can be mailed.

4. Due to the cost, plaques will not be sent overnight or by express.

The Spring Rotating in 2014 is being planned for March 20-23 at Purina Farms Event Center in Gray Summit,

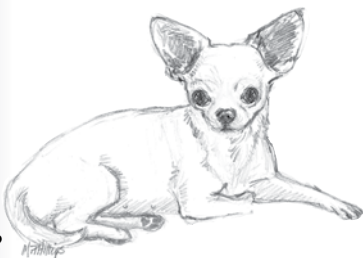

Dick Dickerson moved to appoint Bill McCollister to fill the vacancy created by Patricia Larrisey's death. Don Coughlin seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Dick Dickerson moved to accept the minutes as published. Craig Leslie seconded. Motion carried

Show Chair Report:

Pat Witter reported that since the seminar would be held in the show room, the schedule requires that it end by 9:45 a.m. to allow hotel staff and superintendent to set up the room for the Sweepstakes.

The seminars were videotaped and that the fee was paid with a check from CCA.

Pat Witter requested that the Top Twenty Event be videotaped.

Dick asked about the CHRIF funds item on the Treasurer's report. Response was that the committee had raised the funds.

Committee Reports

Education Committee: The committee is working on revising and

improving the old blue breed information pamphlet.

Top Twenty: Kenny Saenz addressed the board with a preview of the order of the event.

Unfinished Business – none

New Business

Kyle announced that AKC has approved allowing Parent Clubs to designate one national specialty at which Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch could receive a 3 point major if there are twice as many entries in each sex as are required for a 5 point major in that region. That rule will be in effect beginning with our October 2013 National show.

Show Chair presented information on changing the show site beginning in 2013. Current hotel increased prices for rooms from \$109 to \$130, (300 room night requirement) and \$17,000 food requirement, in addition to ballroom cost.

New site will be Holiday Inn in Crystal lake, IL. Room rate is \$109 with a 200 room night requirement. Food purchase requirement is \$1800. Ballroom will cost a total of \$1500 for the whole event. The hotel allows 6 dogs per room. If people book cheaper rates outside the Club's block, they will have to pay a cleaning fee per dog/per night. Under the block, there is also a cleaning fee, but it is less and partially refundable.

In regards to the current hotel, some people made reservations that were cheaper than our group rate, but were not happy when told by the hotel that they could not have dogs in their rooms because they were not part of the block. The Marriott normally does not allow pets

AKC's Complete Dog Book is undergoing its periodic revision. The parent clubs have been invited to contribute. Art Johnson is bringing his writings on topics.

AKC also wants a brief profile for AKC's Family magazine.

Chi Chatter Ads- response has been positive, but the club depends on the income from color ads to cover the increase in printing costs.

Spring Rotating 2014 – Dick Dickerson said that Nashville is interested in hosting 2014. The Sheraton by the airport is available and is \$500 per day.

CCA Hall of Fame

Billy Miller and Kenny Saenz have proposed some Hall of Fame requirements for dogs.

It would require someone to keep statistics. Art Johnson has offered to do that. The Board expressed interest in entertaining a proposal for a Hall of Fame.

Awards Chair – a new chair is needed since Pat Larrisey was responsible for that task.

Dick Dickerson raised the issue of the CCA dates conflicting with his All breed club's weekend and asked if CCA would consider going back to week # 40. No action taken.

Health Issues Committee provided a report on issues it thinks we should fund.

Craig Leslie moved that CCA join the Syringeomylea study. Dick Dickerson seconded. Motion carried.

CCA received a compliment for putting Syringeomylea information on their website.

Maria Sulecki sent a letter to the club asking if there could be a page in the Chi Chatter to allow members to commend other members for service and good works.

Pat Larrisey's plaque for Outstanding Service was sent to her relative. Wording on the plaque will be read to the membership at the general meeting on Saturday.

Craig Leslie moved to adjourn at 7:12 p.m.

New Business

Reserve WD & Reserve WB: The President reported that AKC has voted to allow Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch to receive a 3 point major at a Parent Club's specialty show, provided that the class entries for the sex are at least double the number of entries required in the region for a 5 point major.

Show Report: Show Chair Pat Witter reported on the hotel change for the 2013 October specialty. The Marriott was going to raise the room rate to \$130 per night and require food purchase of \$17000 over the weekend.

The Holiday Inn in Crystal Lake, IL rate is \$109 per night with only a food commitment of \$1800. The dates will be October 11-13, 2013.

AKC Complete Dog Book: AKC is revising the book and needs good photos of Chihuahuas.

Chi Chatter: Ads from members and member clubs are needed in order to

afford to continue to publish in color.

Gloria Lambert asked about the previous Rescue Report and reference to Humane Society of the United States. She objected to any direct links to HSUS. Rescue Chair Linnie Buntun clarified that a separate rescue organization was exploring options for being approved in order to be able to take in dogs in situations such as the large Chihuahua kennel in Ohio. CCA would not be involved with HSUS.

Spring Rotating Specialty: Since no host club has submitted a written proposal for 2014, we have a tentative date in April 2014 for holding a show at Purina Farms near St Louis, MO. Kenny Saenz proposed that Regional Vice Presidents encourage clubs in their areas to host and share profits and expenses.

Billy Miller discussed a CCA Hall of Fame for people and dogs. He wants to get a committee to develop the proposal.

Membership: Patricia Holzkopf will be taking over the duties of Membership Chair.

Outstanding Service Award: Carol Jeffrey read Pat Larrissey's nomination and then Pat's thank you for the award.

Betty Stallard moved to add a late fee of \$5 for dues submitted after January 1 and \$10 for dues submitted after February 1. Dail Corl seconded the motion. Motion carried.

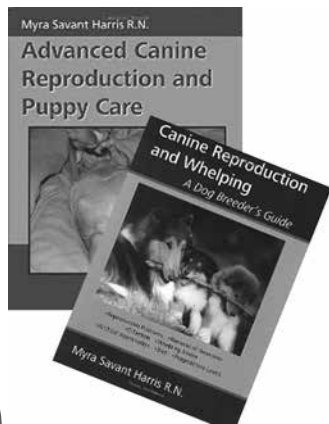

“We all speak the same language,
the language of the love of dogs.” Myra Savant Harris R.N.



I was very pleased when it was suggested to me to check out a Yahoo chat group called *Canine reproduction, Fertility and neonatal changes*. For days I would spend way too much time involved in the lives and adventures of fellow breeders. I know a lot of, if not most of you, are more experienced in dog breeding than I am, but for the most part, I'd like to think that even for you, whelping puppies is pretty darn scary at times. I read the experiences of my fellow breeders as if it was a thriller novel, feeling the roller coaster of all the emotions of hope, delight and despair as they told of their own breeding experiences. As I continued to absorb vicarious emotions, I noticed a name that kept popping up, Myra. I know most of you know of Myra, but I did not. I thought she must be some kind of a doggie guru for all the times I heard "Myra says this", and "ask Myra that". So obviously, I had to find this Myra.

Myra Savant Harris, R.N. has spent a good deal of her time and energies with two things that most of us love, puppies and babies. She has been involved in delivering many babies, furry and non-furry. Yes, to me, Myra seemed to have all the answers so, with haste, I ordered three of her published books. I was not disappointed. Myra says her goal in writing her books is to instruct without hyper-sophisticated medical jargon or highly difficult to repeat professional verbiage. I was hooked right away

reading that after delivering hundreds of babies, when it came to whelping puppies, she is scared. She understands now that her furry patient can't talk. Her goal became to write a book that a fellow breeder can easily understand and undertake without professional help at their side. In my opinion, she has accomplished her goal with all three books. I'm not going to even attempt to give you much information from her books, because well, in my opinion, they are excellent, and easily attainable for your own use.

A few basics Myra might want all breeders to ponder— Why are we breeding? Here are Myra's basic rules when you ask yourself what your motive is for breeding. Don't breed more puppies than you can find a home for, never breed something genetically deformed (testing is required to determine this), never sell to puppy mills or pet stores, if the puppy is pet quality, you must sell it with a spay or neuter contract, agree to always take back a puppy and rehome, pledge to give of your time and energies to be a good mentor. I think we probably know all these "rules" and pay a lot of lip service, but are we in our heart of hearts ethical breeders? If not, do not do it! We must be willing to spay, neuter, or place a puppy that doesn't improve or extend our breed quality, and Myra says, "be brutal!"

A few more of Myra's tidbits: sperm is easily killed, that's why there are so many of them. A show dog can be bathed and blown dry over a show weekend and may not be able to produce puppies with that lovely bitch presented to him on Monday. He needs time to resupply. Water kills sperm; so many an AI has been foiled by that fact alone. Saline solution and non-latex gloves are a must. Your bitch will have her puppies on the 63rd day of her cycle, period. Ovulation begins when the eggs drop, not when they are

fertilized. A runt is not a puppy born too early; it is a puppy that had a bad placement in the mom's uterus. There are two common AI myths: they create smaller litters and more missed pregnancies. Not true, there have been very large litters with AI and most likely missed timing is the breeders fault. The only sexually transmitted bacteria that can cause infertility is Brucella Canis and it must be determined by a blood test. Herpes will most likely kill your litter, but that does not mean your bitch cannot be bred again. Sperm is viable for at least five to seven days, probably more. Bitches ovulate when progesterone level is 5ng/ml. These are what Myra calls the "three Musketeer's of Whelping", Oxytocin, Glucose, and Calcium. Never give your expecting bitch extra calcium in any form before active labor! Lastly, the signs of labor: no appetite, clingy behavior, digging or nesting, licking herself— make sure she always has plenty of water!

Myra's books are full of in depth information. She also sells many of the products she mentions. Her books are: *Canine Reproduction and Whelping*, *Advanced Canine Reproduction and Whelping*, and *Puppy Intensive Care*. I've also heard Myra is now working on a new book. This has not been verified to me by Myra, but is said to be all about the boys. Our precious Studs! Hmm.... so I'll leave you with a pregnant pause about the new book - don't know what the pregnant pause is - Myra does.

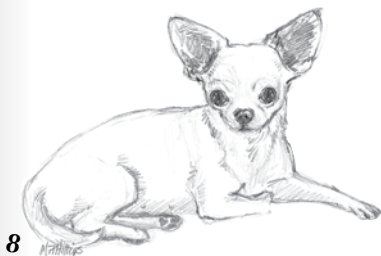

During the judging, exhibitors enjoyed the food and watched as each dog was evaluated. A point system was utilized by the judges to evaluate the dogs. Viola Burgos headed up the tabulation of the point counts. We were very appreciative of the ladies who added up the scores. Board members, Pat Witter and Bill McCollister, took the bull by the horn and collected all of the ballots for the People's Choice Award. There were many votes to be collected and counted.

For the second year in a row, committee co-chair Hazel Bellerjeau and her husband Joe donated the trophies for the Top Twenty event. Both Joe and Hazel worked hard to insure that this event was a success. We owe

Comments From Our 2012 Fall National Specialty

An Interview with Mr. Edd E. Bivin

Perhaps, Mr. Bivin has the distinct honor of judging our national specialty more than any other judge. His Fall 2012 assignment was the fourth Chihuahua National that he has judged. Indeed, this judge's opinion is very well respected in the Chihuahua world.

Mr. Bivin affirmed that our National was well executed and wanted everyone to know that it was a pleasurable experience for him. He felt the overall quality of the exhibits was commendable. Being pleased with his entry in both varieties, our judge felt that there were some promising young dogs. He shared that, generally speaking, the dogs were fairly sound.

He was very pleased with his Best of Variety winners and his Best of Opposite to variety winners. Having shown to Mr. Bivin for many years, I was not shocked that he articulated the importance of head type as a prerequisite when judging our breed. With the quintessential large ears and large, round eyes, the correct expression is created. He was very pleased with the breed type of his winners. Being that there was a nice entry of specials, Mr. Bivin was dutiful in his evaluation of each entry.

Our judge stated that his Winners Dog and Winners Bitch in both Varieties were quality animals. Sharing that the Winners class in Smooth Dogs was of very high quality, Mr. Bivin conveyed that it was enjoyable to adjudicate over such a lovely group of dogs. He does not like overly long, low exhibits.

Mr. Bivin affirmed that our national was well executed and wanted everyone to know that it was a pleasurable experience for him.

Conversely, he does not like the long legged, too short backed animals. Mr. Bivin espoused that his Smooth Coat Winners Dogs line-up represented exhibits that were compact and well balanced without any exaggeration in their proportion and outline.

Anyone who has shown to him is well aware that Mr. Bivin does not tolerate a bad mouth. In his entry, there were fewer problems with overshot and wry mouths than in the past. Noting that this was a serious fault in our breed standard, he commended breeders for working to improve in this area.

Mr. Bivin quipped that there was no "show dog breed standard" and he was focused on rewarding breeding stock that adhered to breed specific traits that make the Chihuahua unique. He did not see any really atrocious headpieces. He addressed the importance of breeders being aware that some tails are carried over the back with more than just the tip touching; almost lying flat on the back. This is faulty and alters the outline of the breed. The Chihuahua should carry their tail in a sickle; out, up, or over the back with the tip just touching.

Mr. Bivin was pleased with the overall condition and temperaments of the dogs. With most dogs having an outgoing and terrier-like disposition, the magnificent character of the breed was

on display at our show. He did suggest that exhibitors be cognizant of the importance of good exercise for toy dogs to build stamina. Although they are toy dogs, Chihuahuas need regular exercise.

This writer enjoyed the conversation with Mr. Bivin. His prodigious approach to focusing his evaluation on breed specific characteristics is so desperately needed. We spent a good deal of time reminiscing about the people and Chihuahuas of the past that had a tremendous impact on our breed today. His long time adoration for the Chihuahua was well noted by this author.
