 JUDGES EDUCATION REPORT; Linda George stated there have been two Judges Education Seminars. 12 attendees today in St Louis and 35 attendees

in Louisville in March of 2017. She thanked all volunteers that allowed their dogs to be used during the seminar.

- \* Subcommittee, Illustrated Standard; Bill McCollister presented the smooth coat illustration that has been approved by the committee that was created by an artist that we hired. He estimated the completion of the long coat version by the end of the year.
- \* Paula McSwain asked who approves the breed colors for registrations, AKC or CCA. She also asked about the possibility of creating examples of the Chihuahua colors. Linda and the committee will further research.
- Jean Pratt requested that judges be asked to stop "sparring" and for them not to be penalized for no sparring. Linda stated she is currently asking judges to stay away from "sparring" and instead ask them to request they "interact with other dogs or their owners".

## 2017 JUDGES CRITIQUES

## 2017 CCA NATIONAL SPECIALTY OCTOBER 14-15, 2017 JUDGE: LAUREN PAYNE

First, and foremost, I would like to thank the membership for the opportunity to judge the national specialty. To have your peers nominate and elect you to judge the national is a tremendous honor; one which will not be forgotten for years to come.

As breeders, you should all be very proud. I have said over the last four years that the quality in exhibits continues to improve year after year. This year was no exception. It was a joy, and challenge, to sort through such high-quality exhibits.

Ringside folks often comment that the long coats are better than the smooths. While this



is sometimes the case, I always state hair hides all manner of faults. The presence of coat softens the faults, whereas smooth coats don't have anything to hide behind.

This year, the quality of the smooth coat class animals was stronger than the long coat class animals. Numerous long coats class animals had incorrect bites. Please be cognizant of your dog's bites. While as breeders' we should never throw out the baby with the bathwater, an incorrect bite is serious fault in our standard.

Additionally, our standard calls for a muzzle that is "moderately short, slight pointed. Cheeks and jaws lean." A small number of exhibits had wide wedge-shaped muzzles, or very short broad muzzles. Both distort expression, and take away from the characteristic saucy expression called for in our standard. That said, it was delightful to see so many dogs exhibiting proper temperament. Our breed should have a terrier like temperament, and own the ground they walk on. And they did.

The quality in the specials ring in both coats was outstanding. Sorting through the exhibits was immensely challenging. Many a lovely exhibit was left out of the ribbons. Even if your dog did not make the final cut, you should be proud.

Our breed is in a great place due to all your hard work and effort. Thank you again, and I wish you all continued success in your breeding programs.

## 2017 CCA REGIONAL SPECIALTY OCTOBER 12-13, 2017 JUDGE: JASON HOKE

Dear Chihuahua breeders and exhibitors,

First of all, thank you for the honor of having me judge the Chihuahua Club of America Regional Specialty. I have to say I was thrilled with the overall quality.

Instead of critiquing individual dogs I was asked to give my overall all impressions of the strengths and shortcomings in the breed. I think all of the biggest improvements I have seen are in two areas. One being movement. The vast majority of the dogs were sound. This shows that structure as well as type is being considered. Gone are the days of the flailing fronts. I commend you for perseverance in correcting this problem. Additionally, the



bites I saw were by in large correct. There were very few over or under bites.

I think that the overall balance of the breed is in great shape. Most fell within the prescribed shape and outline. So overall balance is becoming the norm which pleases the eye. The excessively low or long dogs were not present. It is very hard to create balance in such a small package and I commend the breeders for striving for that overall balance and silhouette.

If I had to say what I saw missing to some degree is the Saucy expression with the lovely full round eye. This coupled with a moderately short muzzle and slightly pointed muzzle. This is not to say the heads were lacking but I do feel there is room for overall improvement to the refinement of type in the head and expression. It's those fine details which takes a very nice chihuahua and elevates it to a dog whose expression excites and melts you at the same time. The expression of the chihuahua is one that is unique to the toy group. They should have the fire of a terrier in the eye yet still have that look of beauty shown in the full eye and expression.

With all that being said, the breed really is in wonderful shape. I can't begin to say when I last judged such a quality entry. The pleasure was all mine.
