



The majority of our local member clubs are not operating formal rescue programs, but do support nearby rescue groups and their efforts. That is basically the approach of the CCA Rescue Committee. We are seeking to identify legitimate rescue organizations across the country. We can provide information, connect requests for assistance from the public and shelters to rescue groups that can help. In July, CCA received a request to help a pair of older long coat Chihuahuas in the Louisiana SPCA that had been dumped by family when owner passed away. I contacted a CCA member who was familiar with some resources in the area who could get the dogs from the shelter on behalf of Texas Chihuahua Rescue and meet a TXCR person to turn them over. On other occasions, we have referred people to other rescues such as Chihuahua Rescue & Transport.

Currently, we are aging. Who is going to care for our dogs when we are no longer able to? I feel that one of the functions of the CCA Rescue Committee should be to help our members plan for the future of their dogs. None of us wants our dogs to go to a shelter when we are no longer able to care for them.

Please contact me if you are interested in this topic. Also contact me if you know of a good Chihuahua type rescue in your area so we can refer people to it as we are contacted. I will be in St Louis at the National weekend if you want to chat.


SUNSHINE CHAIR CHRISTIE FOULK

What are the top three factors when picking a stud? Temperament has to be very near the top. Angulation is critical. Our standard asks for a front well under the dog and rear angulation to match. A pretty head without being extreme was part of the package.
