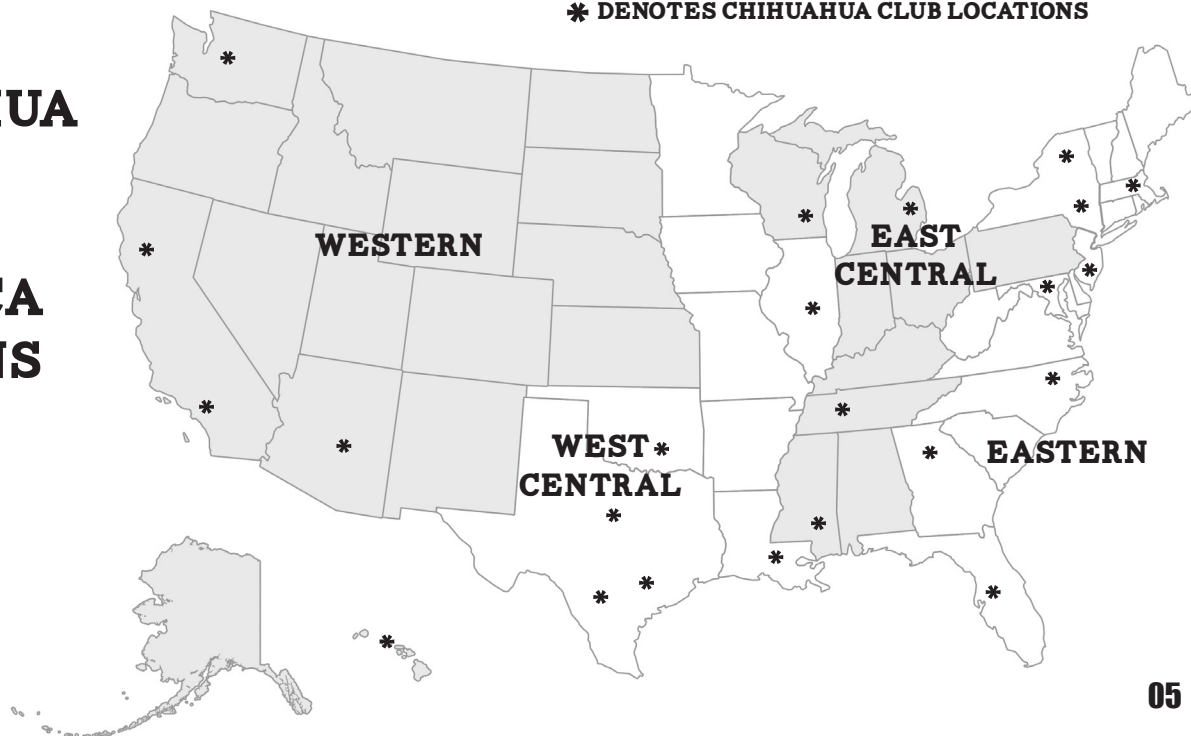

New CHIC Numbers (4th quarter 2017):

There were 25 new or updated CHIC #'s in the 1st quarter of 2018. 3 updated CHIC numbers and 22 new CHIC numbers were issued.

Reminder to all doing OFA health testing; once you submit initial results, RESUBMITS are FREE of charge; simply indicate when you send the updated forms in that it is an UPDATE and you will not be charged. Updating health results during the breeding lifetime of your dog provides even more valuable information past the initial tests.

Submitting all 3 results together can be done for a reduced fee of \$22.50 total vs. The individual application fees.

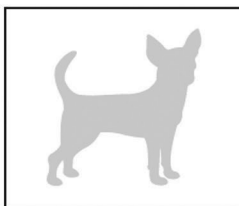
