

AKC Education Summit The Summit began on June 10th, 2018 with a welcome from the AKC. Interesting fact: 68% of American's have a pet. Even more interesting is that the number one pet is the Fish followed by the Cat then our beloved Dog.

- 1. The Evolution of Dog Show and Events presented by Doug Ljungren, AKC Executive Vice. We currently have 17 Sports in 1300 events. We have had 15 years of declining numbers in Conformation events. It was suggested that we may just have too many Conformation shows in some areas and too few in other areas of the Country. This may very well be one of the reasons for declining numbers. Another reason is that 70% of new dog owners agree that adopting/rescuing a dog is there preference. Other mentions for declining numbers also were the inability to attract Generation Z. This generation is one that prefers doing things that lean them selves to a cause, cost value, (FOMO) fear of missing out, and rapid gratification.
- 2. Club Development presented by Glenn Lycan, AKC Director of Event Operations Support The role of this presentation was to help clubs increase membership, add events during their conformations shows, and or stand along shows. The panel shared that, by adding other AKC events, their numbers and profit increased. What clubs might do: Addition fun activities, education, share your story programs, sharing is power, raffle's, utilize social media. Please contact Glenn Lycan or Guy H. Fisher for personalized ideas.
- 3. Junior Showmanship presented by Mar-Beth O'Neill There is a difficulty in bringing in new young members. Some of the items suggested were that we be more active with 4-H, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, and other youth groups. Go to electronic news letters since our youth does not care for hard copies. Try the RHP Clinic's. and not to forget the power of the Pee Wee program. More suggestions were to bring in other events our youth sees as more fun: Trick Dog, Rally, Obedience, and Jr show case events, just to name a few.
- 4. Breed Preservation presented by Mark Dunn, AKC Executive Vice President The fact is that 50 breeds account for 50% of our registrations. Suggestions: reproductive breed bank by the parent club, public awareness, mentoring programs (breeders and exhibitors), sharing more of ourselves (we're all in this together), being more inclusive.
- 5. Best Public Relations and Social Media Practices for Clubs presented by Brandi Hunter This is all about getting our message out of the other things we do. Our rescue programs, community outreach programs, the reunite program. Set up a media committee! Use Social Media: Facebook (monitored), Instagram, and Twitter etc. Don't forget your local TV, and newspapers.
- 6. Government Relations presented by Sheila Goffe.

There was a discussion of using public policy to promote responsible dog ownership. We should all be working with AKC on the local, State, and Federal level. Contact Sheila for in depth information for your area. This could be the catalyst that allows our fancy to continue.
