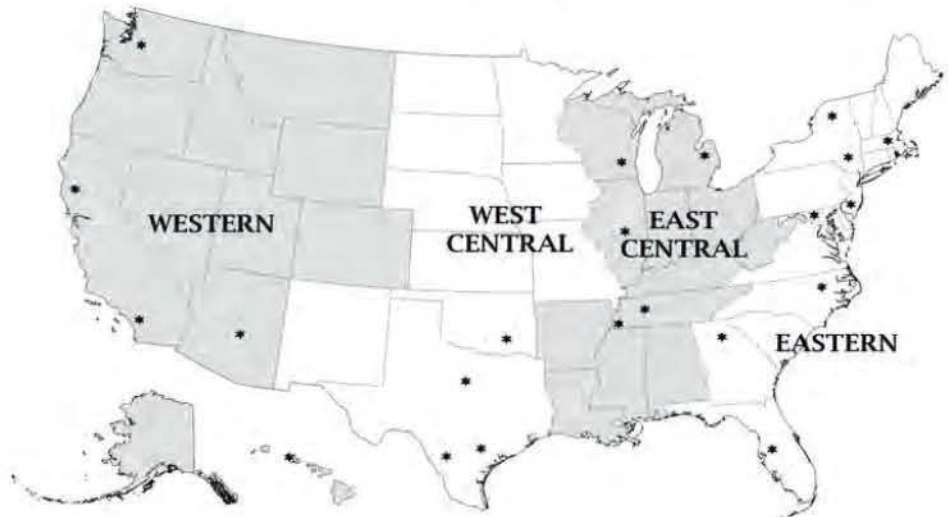

The CCA Treasurer, Sherrie Shirky, has been trying to make sure that we have a signed Code of Ethics on File for each of our members. Last I checked, she had almost reached the goal. Never fear, this is NOT an annual event. We just need one on file and the files will be scanned and in electronic form to make it easier to keep track of them.

The reason I mention this is that one came with a letter from a member about the CCA Code of Ethics and AKC's Code of Sportsmanship. She cited a few examples of some of our members and others in the sport failed to exhibit either Sportsmanship or Ethics. This is a person who is fairly new to the sport and I'm almost surprised that she has not left it.

One person, who didn't really know this lady, came up to her and told her that her 7 year old bitch was too fat. This was an unsolicited comment before the class in which the exhibitor won her first NOHS points on this GCH veteran bitch. Why would anyone go up to a stranger and give unsolicited criticism of their dog?

The lady had only shown a few times, and when she did, she was treated rudely. She wants to learn more about showing. She tried to seek help from an all-breed kennel club near her. The club apparently blew her off. She is persisting in finding ways and opportunities to learn more about showing, in spite of the way she has been treated.

She cited several examples of some of our members being rude and dismissive. Her whole point of this letter was "to point out that if the CCA or AKC want new members, they need to help the newcomers, not discourage them and be rude."

When I read this letter, it reminded me that this is true in our breed, but also in other breeds. Please think about this and look for ways to BE NICE! If a spectator comes up wanting to know more about the breed, find a nice way to talk to them. Explain that you are getting ready to show, but will chat after that is done. Who knows, you might find a protégé, or a home for one of your dogs, or a new friend. Be helpful to new exhibitors. It doesn't hurt to be nice and courteous. Be positive! Be helpful! Be kind!

My thought is that we love our breed. We want it to be promoted and we want shows to continue. The dog club members are aging. Most of our local clubs are finding it very hard to have enough members to put on a show. A couple of our clubs are already gone. Please find ways to encourage and nicely educate the public and people who are interested in our breed.

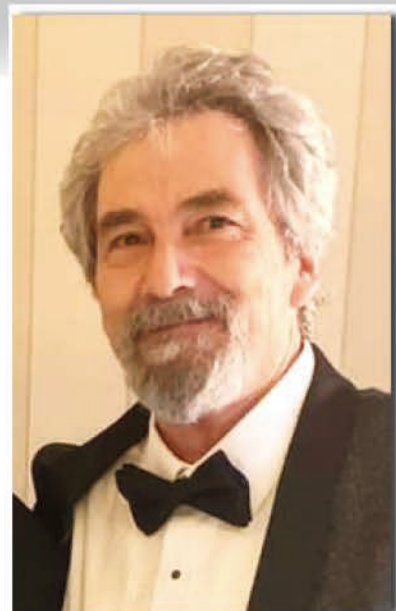

Out of the Chute

The Journey to an Agility Grand Champion

When you take that little fuzzy ball of wiggling puppy home you have no idea where you are going to end up in a couple of years. You have hopes, but at first you are just enjoying all that love.

I knew I was going to do agility with Spicy as I already had 2 agility champion Chihuahuas. We worked our way through the lower levels up to masters and started accumulating MACHs and other titles. At the time we started the AKC did not have a Agility Grand Champion. So we did the other things they had.

To get a MACH or PACH you have to get 750 points and 20 double Qs. In the masters class you cannot make a mistake and have a qualifying run. In our journey we have messed up many runs by getting lost, sending Spicy to the wrong obstacle, or dropping a bar. What is a double Q? That is where you run both the standard and jumpers' courses and qualify in both on the same day. These courses are measured and a allowable time is set for each one. You get 1 point per second for being under that time.

Now keep in mind most standard courses are 160-175 yards long. Jumpers are 150 to 160. It's like running your small dog the length of a football field 3 times. So having a fat Chi will not work in agility. There are also plenty of dogs out there who have thousands of points but just cannot get 20 doubles. I was extremely glad that Spicy was consistent. She might not have been super-fast, but she normally got both her runs. To get a Grand you need 100 qualifying runs in standard and 100 in jumpers. Most folks will get this and more over the course of their journey.

Then they had games which you could also enter. "Fast" which is a distance challenge. This is one of the hard ones for small dogs. In masters you usually have to have your dog do 3 obstacles while you are about 15 feet away from them. There will be a line on the course you can't step over, but your dog must go and do the things on the other side. You also had to figure out how you were going to do the course. In a 8" class you have 38 seconds to get a minimum of 60 points including the "distance send" to qualify. Obstacles will have a point value assigned and it is your job to figure out the best way to get what you need before you run out of time. There are a few different titles in this game you can get. To get a grand you must have 75 qualifying runs in this game. You will have multiple titles in this by the time you get 75 qualifying runs.

The second game is called T2B "time to beat" and it is based on the fastest dog in your height. The course is normally shorter than a standard course, but it is not measured and max time for 8" is 60 seconds. To title in this you need 15 qualify runs and 100 points. To get points it is based on the fastest dog who gets 10. Then your time below that based on a percentage will get you some less amount. Most dogs going for their grand end up with multiple titles like T2B4. You also need 75 qualifying runs in this. Then there is Premier Standard and Premier Jumpers. To get your grand you need 50 qualifying runs in standard and 50 in jumpers. These were new additions to the classes offered at most trials. They were designed in response to folks with multiple MACHs for something more challenging. It takes a lot of team work to qualify in these. Spicy and I had to learn some new skills to be able to compete in this. The AKC is still making adjustments to these classes even this year they added time to the standard course for small dogs.

What makes these so hard is you have to have a dog that is fast and is willing to listen to your commands. Crazy entries into obstacles, jumps you run past and then jump from the back side. You have to be able to call your dog off something right in front of them to take something else. I was lucky Spicy was good at reading what I wanted. The problem was at first jumping 8" a lot of the small dogs were not making time. These courses are not measured. There is a set time regardless of how many obstacles. Normal standard courses are 18 to 20. Premier is 19 -22 and you always have less time. These classes are a real struggle. There are a lot of dogs and handlers who will not be able to do them. I knew Spicy could do the stuff required our problem was time. We had to be perfect, even a slightly wide path resulted in us being over time. Sure, there was also plenty of runs I messed up on too so we both had to be perfect. So for the last year we have done nothing but Premier so that she was fresh and not tired from running the regular classes first. I had to be really on the ball with showing her where we were going. It was the only way at 7 years old I could see to get there. Finally, we finished in Dec at the Harrisburg

Shetland Sheepdog Club trial. It was the first AGCH the club ever had and for the judge it was also the first one she judged. For me, I am still on cloud nine. That I was able to do this with a Chihuahua is still amazing to me. So many people had cheered us on and helped us over the years, there were lots of hugs and a few tears. Spicy didn't care but was happy with the extra steak and all the attention she got.

Would I do it again, you bet. I don't even want to think about the cost. What I know is that Spicy loves the game. I will continue to run her until she tells me she has had enough. Although I will be moving her to a lower height (Preferred) so that she can keep running longer.

To anyone who is thinking about trying agility with their Chi. Go for it. They might be small but most of them love the game. They get to be with you. There will be ups and downs but even the mistakes made years ago taught me what I needed to get here, and the love of this girl has added so much to my life.

Classifying and Newly Subclassifying Medial Patella Luxation in Dogs

While no grading system can truly encompass the complexities of patella luxation, sub-categorization can help guide client discussion

Canine medial patella luxation is a common cause of lameness. While it most often affects small and toy breed dogs,¹ medium and large breed dogs can also be impacted.² Clinical presentation varies depending on the severity (*i.e.* grade) of luxation. Most patients with patella luxation will present at a young age, some as early as three months, but many are around 12 months to four years old.²

Surgical treatment techniques vary depending on the grade, underlying anatomical derangements, and surgeon preference. Case selection for surgical candidates depends on several factors, grade included. What follows is a detailed discussion of the different grades of medial patella luxation, along with an exploration of a subclassification of grade

2. The latter may help in decision making when considering patients which may require surgical treatment.

Grade 1 (No clinical signs associated)

During orthopedic examination, as you fully extend the stifle, if you place slight medial pressure on the patella, it will luxate medially. Slight internal rotation will also elicit luxation. Typically, it is most easily elicited if both the hip and stifle are extended, and the foot is internally rotated slightly. Once the pressure and/or rotation is released, the patella will spontaneously relocate into the trochlea groove. During normal flexion and extension of the stifle, the patella will tend to stay in the groove.

Grade 2

The patient will skip on the affected leg. It does not appear to be very painful, and there is no noticeable lameness in between skipping episodes. Patients with cranial cruciate ligament (CCL) disease will also sometimes have a skipping type of component to their lameness; however, when not skipping, a patient with a CCL rupture will remain mild to moderately lame on the affected limb.

Try to have the patient as relaxed as possible during your orthopedic examination as any tension in the quadriceps muscles may alter your findings. I recommend performing your conscious examination both standing and then repeating it in lateral recumbency, if tolerated by the patient.

Flexion of the stifle in a weight bearing position with internal rotation of the foot will usually cause the patella to spontaneously luxate in a grade 2 medial patella luxation. Release of the rotation and stifle extension will allow the patella to spontaneously reduce into the trochlea groove on the femur.

Grade 2 covers a wide range of severity of the condition. Technically, any luxation that spontaneously reduces into the groove during flexion and extension should be categorized as a grade 2. In some cases, the patella may remain out of the groove for many steps during the patient's gait and in other cases it may only luxate once or twice over 25 yards, yet this category spans them both.

To allow a clearer classification, I suggest sub-categorization as follows:

- **Grade 2A:** The patient skips infrequently during gait and during stance the patella is consistently within the groove.
- **Grade 2B:** The patient skips frequently but during stance the patella is consistently within the groove.
- **Grade 2C:** The patient skips frequently or walks with a consistent lameness, suggestive that the patella is out of the groove during most of the gait. On palpation, there are times when the patella is not within the groove. If the limb is flexed and extended the patella spontaneously returns to the trochlea groove.



Grade 3

The patient will walk with an altered gait due to an internal rotation of the tibia and altered quadriceps biomechanics. The hock will be abducted and the foot internally rotated (Figure 1). The limb, and whole rear end in the case of bilateral disease, will appear crouched or hyper flexed compared to normal (Figure 2). Many cases of grade 3 patella luxation are bilaterally affected, although the grade on the other pelvic limb can be less, the same, or worse. The patella will not be within the groove, but you will be able to manually manipulate it back in, only for it to luxate as soon as manual pressure is released.

In small dogs, it can sometimes be tricky to discern the patella. Palpating the lateral femur and following it down to the stifle, it is then possible to move your fingers across the cranial and distal end of the femur where you will palpate the trochlea groove. Normally, the groove is not palpable because the patella is within it. Finding the tibial tuberosity and then following proximally up the patella tendon will aid in location of the patella. Typically, these dogs will have an internally rotated tibia with a medially positioned tibial tuberosity and, therefore, the tuberosity will be positioned very medially in comparison to the femur. A craniocaudal radiograph of the femur can confirm the diagnosis and direction of luxation.

Grade 4

The patient's gait will be similar to that which is described for grade 3, with abduction of the hock, internal rotation of the foot, and increased flexion of the stifle, giving a crouched and "bow-legged" appearance. Intermittent non-weight bearing can be seen, likely due to some discomfort as the patella moves over the medial aspect of the femur.

Figure 4: Computed tomography scan of the right femur from the patient in Figure 3 with lines drawn to demonstrate excessive femoral varus of 103 degrees. The tibia will be internally rotated, sometimes with up to 90 degrees internal rotation (Figure 3).

It will not be possible to move the patella towards or into the groove and attempting to do so will often cause discomfort to the patient. The quadriceps muscles will be shortened and tight due to the medial position of the patella and most cases will have femoral varus medial bowing (Figure 1), which will enhance the "bow-legged" appearance of these cases.

Surgical intervention

Grades 3 and 4 are considered surgical candidates, as patients are unable to walk with a normal gait. Early surgical intervention aims to reduce secondary effects, such as progressive osteoarthritis and cranial cruciate ligament rupture.³ Grade 2 patella luxation cases can also benefit from surgical intervention; however, the risks of surgery must be weighed against the benefits in each individual case. Grade 2C cases will usually be good surgical candidates with a noticeable improvement following surgical correction.

Grade 2B patients should be considered on an individual case by case basis. Grade 2A and grade 1 cases can often be monitored for progression of disease and surgical intervention reconsidered if this occurs. The effect on a patient's quality of life is usually minimal when disease is classified as low grade. Cases can progress from a lower to a higher grade over time. As such, ongoing monitoring is recommended. Patients with medial patella luxation can also rupture their cranial cruciate ligament, which can lead to an acute progression (e.g. from a grade 2A to a grade 3, due to the increased internal rotation of the tibia without the cranial cruciate ligament intact). While no grading system can truly encompass the complexities of a disease such as patella luxation, hopefully this description and additional sub-categorization can help guide decision-making and client discussion.

Do You Really Have The Time



After writing a recent article, I had a breeder judge from another breed send me an email message. She complimented me for encouraging others in our breed to socialize their puppies. She said something similar to, "I wonder how many will read this and implement any sort of corrective action(s). Seeing a Chihuahua crawl around the ring on its belly is much less than a pretty sight." These are not her exact words, but the message is the same.

Over the many years I have known our breed I have been amazed that socialization, training, grooming, conditioning, etc. are not priorities for many. I have heard it all too often, "I just don't have the time." I have to wonder why a person would produce a litter of puppies knowing they do not have the necessary time for the important list of things above.

Preparing a puppy for the show ring takes lots of time on a daily basis. If you cannot budget at least 20-30 minutes daily to each puppy in a litter after they are eight weeks old, you most probably should not have bred the litter. A fair question would be how can it take 20-30 minutes daily per puppy? This is easily answered when we think of individual socialization, lead breaking, bait training, table training, grooming, attention to nails, teeth cleaning, etc. Bringing a ring ready puppy to a given show has taken the exhibitor many hours on an on-going basis.

The Judge's Verdict - Dick's Thoughts

Mr. Richard Miller, AKC Judge - CCA Life Member

When I was actively showing, I was too often amazed to see nails being cut at ring side. This often resulted in bleeding and much resistance from the dog being prepared for the ring. Grinding nails weekly keeps them ring ready on an on-going basis and results in no bleeding. I was also amazed to see much scissoring done at ring side along with stripping knives being used. All of this "fussing with the dog" is often very frustrating to that dog and results in less than a stellar performance once in the ring. Dogs that have had grooming done on an on-going basis need only a touch up before they enter the ring.

I am amazed to see the filthy mouths that come into the ring when I am judging. This is too often the case with many toy breeds. I firmly believe in brushing teeth with a diluted mouth wash several times a week. What is the result of this brushing is a fair question. The brushing of the teeth has at least three positive outcomes. They are as follows: (1) The dog gets used to having its mouth opened without a fight on the examination table. (2) The mouth is sparkling clean on examination. (3) The health of the gums of the dog is positively impacted by this activity. Careful attention to mouths will result in dogs of perhaps 8 years of age having all their teeth and the gums showing no indication of inflammation. Care of the mouth is essential from my perspective; however, it is time consuming.

As the day of the show nears it is critical to work daily for several weeks on careful grooming. Using a mirror to see what others will see is essential. It was my experience that grooming a smooth coat took me much longer than grooming a long coat. I usually did basic scissoring about six weeks out from the actual show date on a smooth coated dog. This allowed for coat to grow in and allow for a more natural looking end product on the day of the show. What tools did I use grooming either coat variety is a fair question. This list may not be all inclusive, but it is close. I used a fine comb, slicker brush, pin brush, thinning shears, a small clipper, stripping knife and scissors. Here again this is a huge investment in time. Some feel we our breed should not require much grooming. I totally disagree. If we are to compete successfully in the show ring, we should enter the ring with a dog that does not look as if it is groomed. Actually, it has had weeks of careful grooming prior to the show.

My purpose in writing this article is to encourage others to make assessments of time before a litter is produced. Only when we are truthful with ourselves and ready to invest the time will we have ring ready specimens. I ask again...Do you have the time?

CHIC, working with participating parent clubs, provides a resource for breeders and owners of purebred dogs to research and maintain information on the health issues prevalent in specific breeds.

New in 2022 - The CHIC number will now appear on AKC documents such as Certified Pedigrees, Registration Applications, and Registration Certificates. This will make it clear to potential puppy buyers and fellow fanciers that the recommended tests and screenings have been performed on a breeder's dogs.

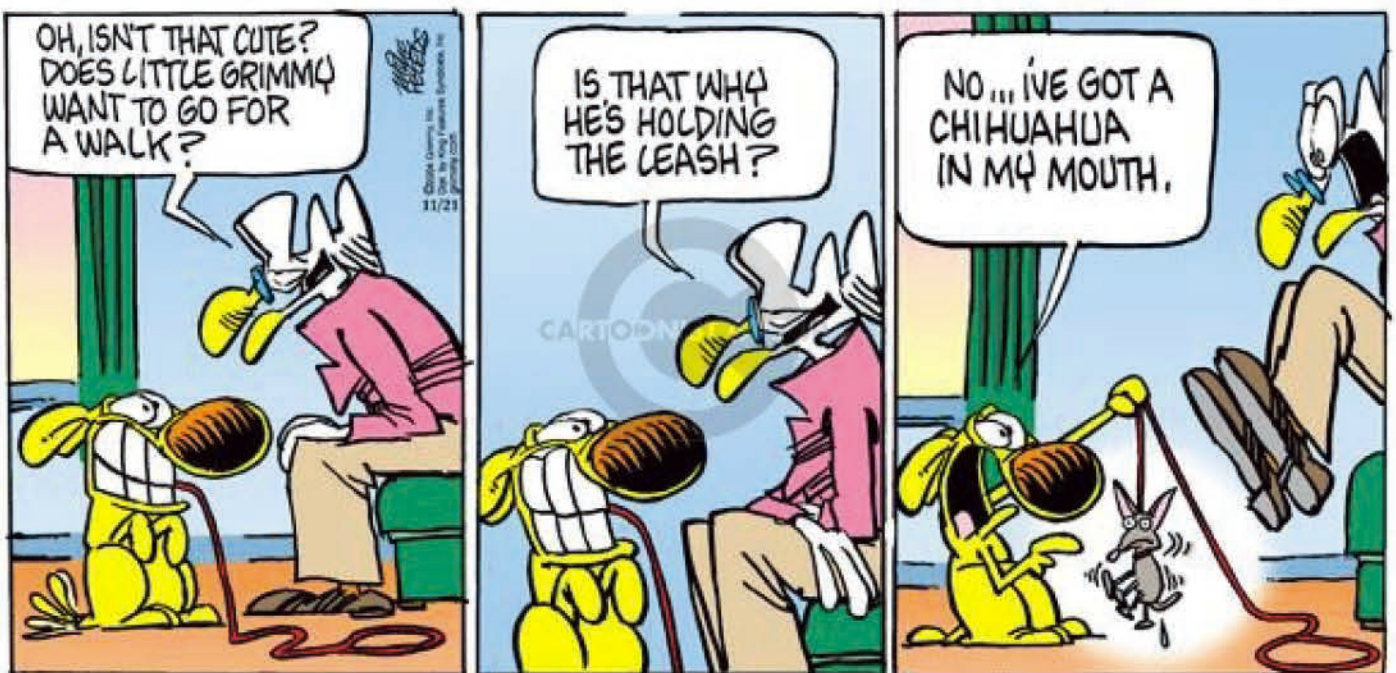

Have Good Sportsmanship Online— Not Just At Dog Shows

Regardless of what dog sport you compete in, it's important to have good sportsmanship when engaging with fellow competitors. But good sportsmanship should extend beyond in-person shows and include how dog owners interact online. The AKC Code of Sportsmanship explains that good sportsmanship involves respecting the sport, club officials, and other competitors, as well as being welcoming to newcomers to the fancy.

Most competitors are thoughtful about being good sports when on showgrounds, but when sitting at a keyboard in front of a glowing screen, good sportsmanship doesn't always remain front and center. Regardless of if you're in a private group for your local kennel club or part of a Reddit forum focused on your breed or dog sport, it's important to center ideas on good sportsmanship.

Maintaining positive interactions online matters as much as it does in person and is key for keeping dog sports welcoming. In all interactions online and in person try treating fellow dog people the way that you would want to be treated.

Respecting Differences

Respecting differences and diversity should always be at the forefront of your mind when engaging with dog people—or any person—online. Try to remember that as long as someone's dog isn't being hurt or endangered, it's perfectly OK for people to approach an aspect of training or competition differently than you do. One of the beautiful things about the online dog community is the opportunity to engage with a wide range of people and their dogs who are coming from different places and experiences.

Some people are just looking to do something fun and casual with their dog, while other dog owners are striving for top scores every time they enter the ring. Both approaches to dog sports are valid and it's important to remember that there are different goals and priorities when training.



Be Welcoming

It's necessary to aspire to be welcoming and inclusive of all people and dogs interested in getting involved in our sports and community. For some, online spaces are their first interaction with the dog community. The comments you say, the way you treat people, and interact with them can have a very real impact on how those people will feel about joining a sport or training, and if they want to stay involved.

Even if those people look different or have different backgrounds from you, they and their dogs should feel welcome. There can be a lot of insider language, abbreviations, and acronyms that can be confusing to people new to dog training or sports. Try to be patient and welcoming with answering questions people might ask online instead of just telling them to go read the sport's rules and regulations. These initial impressions of a sport and interactions with other competitors can be the difference between a dog owner continuing to train their dog or walking away.

Virtual Classes

Online training classes have become increasingly popular since the beginning of the pandemic. Virtual classes have been a fantastic opportunity for seasoned competitors to work on skills with their dogs from home, and for those new to dog sports to start building skills. Similarly, as virtual titling options in sports, like Agility, Trick Dog, Rally, Obedience, and Scent Work, become more common, it's especially important to treat any of those videos shared online the same way you would react standing ringside at a show.

One of the challenges of virtual titling is that other competitors can rewind and rewatch to closely scrutinize a dog and handler's performance. This is very different from being at a dog show where you might catch someone's turn in the ring, but there's a limit to how closely you can watch. Plus, with online comments, it can be difficult to read the tone behind what is being said, which can lead to unintentionally hurt feelings.

If you're an instructor or a participant in the online class, be generous and thoughtful about what you say and how you say it when giving feedback, critique, or criticism to other dog owners.

Seek Consent Before Critiquing

All of us have opinions, and dog people understandably have very strong opinions about the right and wrong way to do things. If you're an experienced competitor or a professional trainer it can feel tempting to want to share your knowledge with others online. But unless you are the instructor and someone is in your class or a handler is doing something that is immediately putting their dog in danger, ask consent before giving training feedback.

Once you have permission for feedback you can give gentle criticism, but respect the handler if they say "no." Although you might know how to teach something or have suggestions that could improve performance, part of good sportsmanship is recognizing that people don't always want your opinion and that sharing suggestions without consent can be incredibly off-putting.

No Bullying Allowed

Bullying of any kind isn't acceptable in the dog world and shouldn't be tolerated online. If you moderate an online discussion space or Facebook group, consider creating an anti-bullying policy for the group. Ideally, people will choose to communicate respectfully but that isn't always the case. Having clear rules that bullying will not be tolerated and moderating group interactions can help make your online groups safer and feel welcoming to a diversity of people.

When looking at videos people are posting of training sessions, experiences in the ring, or submissions for virtual titles it's important to be encouraging and supportive. Always consider if what you are typing to someone is something you would say to their face at a dog show. Otherwise, you don't need to say it to someone online.

No member shall use social media to make derogatory comments – direct or implied – about another member, the club, or the Board of Directors. Such conduct may be considered incompatible with continued membership and may lead to the expulsion of that member.

Tips to Prevent & Stop Cyberbullying

Access to social networks is a valuable tool for sharing experience and advice among animal breeders. However, dog breeders and others who own and interact with animals, are at risk of being targeted on social media by animal rights (AR) activists. AR activists typically oppose the breeding or use of animals. Some activists equate animal ownership to slavery. Their long-term goal is seeking an end to animal ownership and breeding.

What is Cyberbullying?

Bullying is not limited to school yards. Anonymous freedom of expression on social media can result in the use of digital technology to harass, threaten, or humiliate. Cyberbullying does not require face-to-face contact, physical power, or strength. When made online and in view of hundreds, attempts to humiliate, harass, or threaten a person with false accusations can happen anytime and follow you anywhere so that no place feels safe, not even your home.

How to Prevent Cyberbullying

People concerned about their privacy can consider the following:

- Using your name, search the internet for what public information exists about you. You may want to use a P.O. Box if your contact information is publicly available.
- Set your profile settings to private and omit personal information like your phone numbers, physical address, and email addresses.
- Check the privacy properties of the groups you join because links to other people and affiliations with public groups pose a threat to privacy.
- Do not attack or insult anyone while participating in discussion groups - state your position objectively and factually.
- Protect your accounts by not sharing passwords.
- Block others from directly posting to your page, until you review and allow the content.
- Avoid sharing sensitive information online, such as health status and vacation plans.
- Watch for "red-flags" -- for example, someone inquiring where you live or work.

Taking Action

If you become the target of cyberbullying, some suggested actions include:

- If the harasser is known to you, request removal of the post and make it clear that you do not want contact.
- Do not respond or retaliate - a reaction is what aggressors are looking for.
- Save the evidence by taking a screen shot from your phone or printing it out without making any changes to it.
- Keep a log of any harassing activity.
- Block and report features are available on all social media platforms. Make sure to use them if you are worried about an individual.
- If you're getting threats of physical harm, contact your local police right away.
- Consult an attorney on available legal remedies; such as an injunction to stop the conduct or claims of defamation and intentional infliction of emotional distress.
